



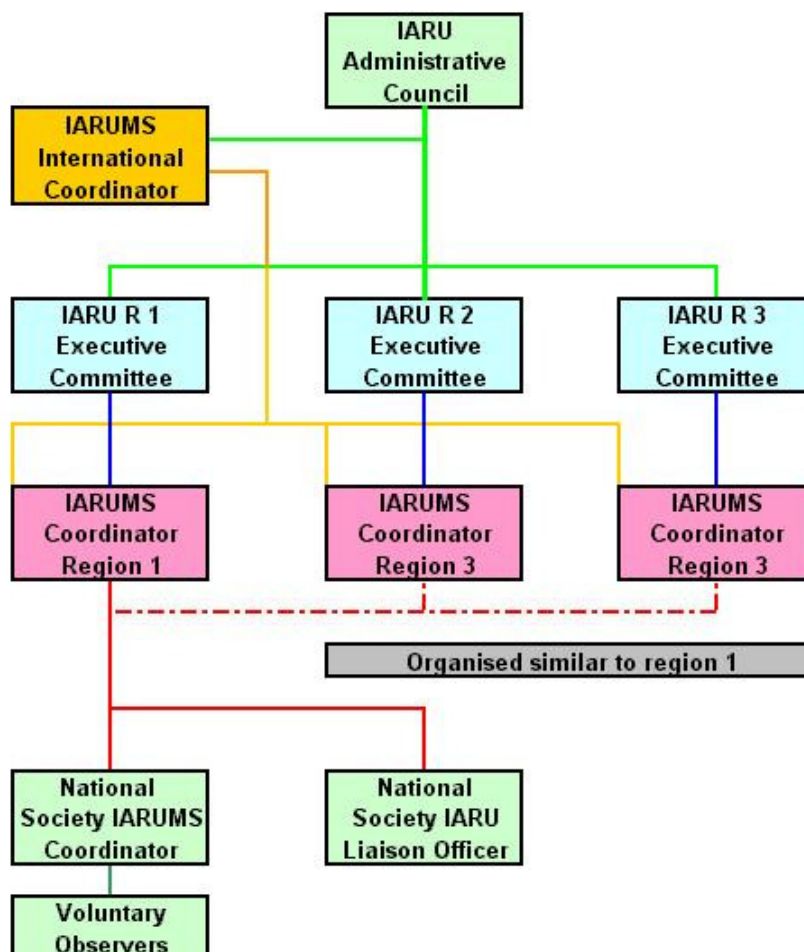

The structure of the IARU

The following diagram will help you to understand the structure of the IARU.



Of course the DARC Monitoring Service is integrated into the DARC (light green rectangle) and a part of the DARC HF-Referat. Being under one roof together with the IARU Monitoring System does not mean that the DARC system is located at the same level as the IARU Region 1 Monitoring System on our diagram above!
